

Full Criteria

We are looking for projects that:

- Are run by students from a Santander partner university see here
- Are realistic, viable and will commence in 2018
- Clearly demonstrate defined goals and objectives
- Benefit a minimum of 10 people

Some examples of the type of projects which would be eligible include:

- Create or run a student society
- Support a charitable or social cause
- Run a university, community or student focused project that addresses a student challenge, priority or issue

If your project is eligible Santander will pledge up to 50% of your crowdfunding target to the maximum of £2,000 once you have raised funds equivalent to the match being sought. e.g. If your target is £3,000 Santander will pledge £1,500, once you have raised the first £1,500 on Crowdfunder.co.uk. If your target is £6,000 Santander will pledge £2,000, once you have raised the first £2,000 on Crowdfunder.co.uk.

You must reach 100% of your crowdfunding target to receive the funding from Santander.

You must provide an impact report via Santander Fellows within 30 days of receiving the funding.

Note, Santander may consider pledging more than the limit of £2,000 per project for those that deliver the greatest impacts/number of beneficiaries.
