

Lambeth Council

London Borough of Lambeth (LBL) may pledge up to 25% of your target to a maximum of £1,250.

Before completing your application for match-funding we ask that you read the accompanying guidance notes fully. [Read here.](#)

To be considered for match-funding from Lambeth Council the project will need to meet some simple criteria.

Funding available to support new community projects & initiatives making Lambeth a unique place to live, work, learn and do business.

All applicants must be aged 18 years or over at the time of submitting the application.

The project must contribute to one or more of the CLIPs criteria:

Building stronger communities and encouraging civic pride
Improving the health and wellbeing of local people
Improving access to parks and open spaces

The project must contribute to one or more of the Borough Plan Priorities:

Inclusive Growth
Reducing inequality
Strong and sustainable neighbourhoods
The project must demonstrate that it has strong local support shown through a vibrant crowdfunding campaign.

The Council is only able to match-fund projects that are being delivered by constituted organisations. This includes community groups, social enterprises, residents or traders associations, local charities, schools, and neighbourhood forums.

On your match-funding application form you will be asked to write a statement about how your project meets the criteria. Please be familiar with the criteria and pitch your project accordingly.

The trigger point for being considered for match-funding, will be once a project reaches 25% of its fundraising target from the crowd.

If projects are successful in securing match-funding, they will need to secure the remaining balance through crowdfunding and hit 100% of their funding target for the Lambeth Council match-fund amount to be released.
