Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to the “Spring Term 2021 Rocketboost ” promotional campaign (to be referred to as the “**Campaign**”).

1. The Promoter is **Rocketfund** which is part of **Crowdfunder Ltd**, C-Space 5-7 The Crescent, Newquay, TR7 1DT (Rocketfund.org).
2. The campaign opens at 00:00am on 22nd Feb 2021(the “**Opening Date**”) and closes at 11:59pm on 1st April 2021 (the “**Closing Date**”) (the “**Promotional Period**”). **No projects will be accepted before the Opening Date or after the Closing Date.**

Eligibility criteria

3. Projects must meet the following criteria to be entered automatically into the Campaign:
 - a. You must start your project by clicking the “Click here to enter” button on www.rocketfund.org/kit4kids
 - b. You (the project owner) must be 18 years of age or over and be a UK resident.
 - c. You must be running a crowdfunding project on Rocketfund.org to raise money for your project (Project).
 - d. Your Rocketfund.org project must be for the benefit of a school in the UK.
 - e. You may only launch one eligible project on Rocketfund.org during the Promotional Period.
 - f. Your Project must meet the following criteria:
 - i. Project must launch on Rocketfund.org within the Promotional Period.
 - ii. Project must raise **£200**.

- iii. Project must receive a minimum of 5 donations from different people (different names, address, bank cards and email addresses).

4. The first 10 Projects to meet the criteria in 3 above (Winning Projects) after the Opening Date will be notified by email and will each be offered a pledge of £200 to their project subject to the project owner accepting these terms and conditions.
5. If the project owner does not respond within 72 hours or declines the offer, the offer will be withdrawn and the Promoter will repeat steps 4 and 5 until 10 pledges have been made by the Promoter.
6. If there are multiple entries from 1 school, only 1 Project per school will be awarded a pledge.

General

7. The winners may be announced on the Promoter's social channels at the discretion of the Promoter.
8. Project owners are responsible for all expenses incurred as a result of participating in this campaign. This may include, but is not limited to, costs associated with the running a project on Rocketfund.org, production of a promotional video, purchasing images or promoting the project.
9. The winners agree to be the subject of, and participate in, a case study to be published on the Promoter's web and social channels for the purposes of promoting the Promoter's services and/or future campaigns if the Promoter requests it.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the campaign or these terms and conditions at any stage but will only do so for reasons outside of their reasonable control. The Promoter will endeavour to minimize the effect of such cancellation or amendment on participants in order to avoid disappointment.
11. The Promoter accepts no responsibility or liability for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft, destruction, alteration of, or unauthorised access to entries, or entries lost, incomplete or delayed whether or not arising during operation or transmission as a result of server failures, virus, bugs or other causes outside its control. All lost, damaged or incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
12. The Promoter, in its sole discretion, may disqualify any Project at any stage for providing untruthful, inaccurate, misleading information and/or is otherwise in breach of these Terms.
